Code of Conduct for Parents, Managers and Players

Everyone at JMPB is expected to adhere to the following Codes of Conduct.

1. Parents, Managers, Coaches and Umpires are to recognize that they are role models and examples for the players and conduct themselves accordingly.
 - a. Show good sportsmanship at all times.
 - b. No swearing or abusive language.
 - c. No ridicule or harassment of umpires.
 - d. No verbal abuse or ridicule of any player.
 - e. No physical abuse (pushing, grabbing or shoving) of any player, coach, or umpire.
2. Any physical conflict will result in law enforcement being called to handle the situation.
3. There will be no changing or adjusting of their team's roster, all changes will be made by the league's Board Members.
4. The manager is responsible for all the players on his/her team. No ridicule of each other or of those players on the opposite team will be tolerated. Constructive criticism is the responsibility of the manager, not the players.
5. The players conduct on the field and in the dugout is the responsibility of the manager.
6. The manager should encourage participation by all players. Never discourage a player's involvement. Each player should feel they are an important part of the team.
7. Please, direct all issues of conflict to the division director, who will be responsible for the resolution of their division issues. If a division director is unavailable, the issue will be handled by the board.
8. If a manager and/or coach is found to be slandering JMPB in a manner that JMPB feels is not in the best interest of the league that manager/coach may be asked to leave the league.
9. Sunflower seeds are not allowed on JMPB Property.

Any Manager and/or Coach can and will be relieved from participation in the JMPB program if it is determined that their conduct violated either the letter or the spirit of the Code of Conduct or the Rules and Regulations to which this code is a part.
